Registration Information: The cost of camp is \$295 per camper. A \$50 non-refundable deposit must accompany each registration. This will leave a balance of \$245 due by JULY 11. Limited scholarships are available, please ask. Registrations should be completed no later than May 31. After May 31 the cost of camp will be \$325.
